- II. Policy Statement: It is the policy of KI to welcome visitors and guests to our High Holiday Services without charge.
- III. History: In 1981, High Holiday cards were issued by the Financial Secretary to family units. Ushers were to direct those without cards into the Auditorium for a piped in simulcast service. This did not apply to students or military personnel with ID. In 1990 a charge of \$25 per guest pass was issued to families new to the area.

- a. KI visitors to High Holiday Services are encouraged to register in advance; however, they will be admitted free of charge with proper ID.
 - b. A suggested donation of \$54/guest pass for adults and \$18 per child to attend all Services will be included with the letter accompanying the passes.
 - c. Guests are requester to enter via the 23rd. Street entrance and should be prepared to show proper ID.
 - d. KI will match any such donation up to \$500 if the visitor subsequently joins KI within the year.
 - e. Muhlenberg students will be admitted via the 23rd St. entrance with student ID.
