Policy, Practice or Guideline: Yahrzeit List

- I. Introduction: Being named on the Yahrzeit is a benefit of membership
- II. Practice Statement: Once a family is no longer a member of KI, the family name(s) will be removed from the Yahrzeit List unless a Memorial Plaque has been purchased.
- III. History: In the past it was decided that in order for current members to see their loved ones plaques, Families who no longer belong to KI would have their Plaque relocated to the top tier of the array. This became an onerous process and was discontinued on 2016.
